The organization is approximately 6 years old and is a fully functional homeless shelter with 38 beds. There is a men's side and a women/children's side to the facility. The organization serves 3 meals per day, 7 days per week. Residents can enter the facility, if there is space, for 14 days on an emergency basis but if they want to stay longer they must enter their Catalyst program. The Catalyst program can last up to 2 years if residents continue to follow the guidelines and make progress. During this program residents are paired with a mentor and receive training, counseling, and resources on how to become self-sufficient. At this time, the greatest needs for Fellowship Missions is for volunteers to serve meals, prep meals, mentor residents, and expand their administrative staff. Eric suggested that one of their long-term plans would be to provide transitional housing for residents that would serve as a transition between the shelter and becoming a fully functioning self-sustaining individual.
